I. A Student Initiated Policy Revision

- In 2011, ASNMSU President Austin Graham & ASNMS Supreme Court Justice Diane Flores introduced these ideas
- Modeled after Oklahoma State Policy (revised/condensed 2015)

Key elements of OSU Model:

Consistency & transparency across campus

Different levels of sanctions

Clear and Fair Appeals process

2011 Advancing Leaders Program Report on Academic Integrity
(Peer Comparison/best practices/Interviews with Academic Deans)

2 key recommendations:

1. Create an institutional Office for Academic Integrity
2. Create a Flowchart to describe how allegations of Academic Misconduct are Handled
