Title: Memorial to Change the Implementation Date for Fractional Grading Policy

Proposal:

This memorial is in reference to Faculty Senate Proposition 12-10/11 “A Proposal to Change the NMSU Grading System By Assigning Point Values to Plus/Minus Grades” which was approved by the NMSU faculty senate in April 2011.

The Faculty Senate of New Mexico State University endorses a change in the implementation date for Proposition 12-10/11 to the date of **July 2013** to allow the registrar’s office and the greater university community adequate time to prepare for this change in grading policy.

Rationale:

Whereas there have been unforeseen delays in the implementation of Faculty Senate Proposition 12-10/11 that was approved by the NMSU Faculty Senate in April 2011,

And whereas, the Registrar’s office would benefit from adequate lead time to prepare for this change in grading policy,

And whereas the NMSU Faculty Senate fully recognizes the expressed desire of the NSMU Student Senate (ASNMSU) to extend the implementation date beyond the initially proposed date of July, 2012,

Be it resolved that the NMSU Faculty Senate endorses a change in the implementation date for Proposition 12-10/11 to the date of July 2013 to provide the Registrar’s office and the greater university community adequate time to prepare for this change in grading policy.
