I attended November 11 meeting, 1-3pm

- Common Course Numbering crosswalk is being worked on
- First reads for Minors in Social Media Management and Strategic Communications; Chemistry MS and PhD Curriculum changes, Minor in Archeology

    - Please spread the word that end of semester qualitative evals need to be set up at the department level and they can no longer do the "one-off" custom evals for individuals
    - U of Oregon presentation through Teaching Academy
      - We are further ahead on technology solutions than U of Oregon
      - Looking at new Watermark EvalKIT qualitative data analysis tool \$5k implementation and \$5k a year, Will put forward to IT Governance
      - Need improvements to map eval data to manually cross-listed courses in Canvas
