Currently, I am attending Acting Provost Scott's meetings titled Deans/Faculty Senate Chair meetings. We met on January 25, 2022.

- Chancellor Arvizu provided an update regarding upcoming interim and permanent searches for
 provost. From this meeting it is my understanding that he is going to do the interim provost
 identification with the registry as quickly as possible and plans to include faculty senate, deans,
 relevant administrators, and provost direct contacts for both interim and permanent scenarios.
- Additionally, reports were provided indicating that the searches for the deans of Colleges of HEST & Business and the search for Chief Information Officer are making progress.
