Summary:

The committee heard from Faculty Senate Leadership (Chair Fasenko and Vice Chair Bronstein) about methods to propose changes to ARPs and timelines for doing so. Megan Papesh updated the committee about her plans to speak to individuals who process Viewing a Wider World waivers so the committee can continue to make progress addressing any ambiguities and inconsistencies in the policy or its application. The committee discussed proposed changes to ARPs 4.02 through 4.50, with plans to revisit (a) proposals that generated much discussion or (b) ambiguous statements in original policy that need further investigation. The remaining ARPs in Chapter 4 will be added to the committee's agenda for February.
