
February Student Success Committee meeting 2.16.23

Dr. Lauren Goldstein works in the Office of Vice Chancellor and was asked to give us an update on the Aggie Pathways program. Dr. Goldstein and her team are overseeing the NACUBO Strategic Finance Grant they received in January 2022, which is looking at programs such as Aggie Pathways, STAR and Achieving the Dream for improvement in ease and support for transfer students moving towards their four-year degree and expanding scholarship opportunities. The overall grant proposal includes goals for students, faculty and staff that will promote student success through communication, programs and systems.



We also discussed the flow chart draft for students, revised our format to be more of a FAQ with scenarios connected to the right services. Senator Phoebe Dugas is currently working on revising the APR 4.46 language for better inclusivity and diversity of our student population.
