MINUTES

1. Call to Order - Meeting called to order at 4:01 p.m.

2. Recognition of Guests

Becky Corran - Adjunct Contract Extensions Joined by Dr. Liz Schirmer (English, A&S)

- Professors Corran and Dr. Schirmer provided a brief insight into the legislation put forth in the fall related to adjunct contract extensions.
- Faculty were part of a Task Force on Faculty Appointments.
- Faculty Senate passed legislation to explore how to do longer term contracts for adjuncts.
- As a result of faculty advocacy, the Provost asked to look at this more carefully and continue this work.
- The NMSU English department has been piloting a step toward the proposed model.
- There are real and imagined barriers, dollar signs, and opportunities. The pilot that they're working on is a place to test all of those things.
- Current practices are wildly varied across campus. Research was conducted to see how many adjuncts each campus or college are using adjuncts as they are defined.
- This year the Legislature proposed a minimum salary for adjuncts, which did not pass. There is a cultural and political imperative for us to think more compassionately about our adjunct colleagues and make sure that they are integrated into our system.
- All of the institutions are competing for adjuncts and there are varying salaries. This model would allow for more collaborative hiring and pedagogical consistency across all System campuses.
- In the long term, the plan is to build policies that can accommodate the whole range of hiring, but at some level provide a step up for adjuncts that would allow them to get health insurance and be hired on a full-time basis on a longer contract.
