Faculty Senate DEI Meeting: January 17, 2024

The meeting convened at 4:05pm

Absent: Olivas

The committee discussed and made a few non-substantive amendments to proposition 6, the proposition to change the senate bylaws to include mandatory onboarding, which then passed unanimously.

Afterward, the committee had a short discussion of what else might be on the agenda for a DEI committee. Senators Bond and Bronstein may collaborate on a proposition about faculty communication, both within the senate and among the faculty at large, but this will be worked on outside of the committee.

The committee meeting ended at 4:25.

I also attended the Systemwide Diversity Council meeting on 1/19. The diversity council has been divided into 5 subcommittees, and the chair of Faculty Senate DEI is assigned to the subcommittee on expanding hiring and retention of underrepresented staff and faculty.

**Important to note: the VP of DEI is in the process of hiring an Associate VP of DEI because she is finding her workload is too much for one person; and the two of them will also be looking to hire an Affirmative Action specialist.** At one point Faculty Senate was concerned about the number of NMSU administrators proliferating while faculty hiring stagnated, so this might be something to keep an eye on.
