- Search is currently in the recruitment phase with review of candidates expected sometime in December 2023

Meeting Updates:

- 1) NMSU Administrative Leadership & Faculty Senate Leadership Committee (FSLC)
 - President Gogue update:
 - State of NM expecting a 3.4 billion dollar revenue increase over last year due to oil and gas revenues
 - State planning on putting much of the funding into reserves so that the state will have funds available after oil and gas prices drop (anticipated drop ~2030)
 - o NM legislature is strongly supporting projects that need one time funding
 - State of NM Senators are concerned about evaluation from "National Council for Teacher Quality" which gave NMSU a grade of "D" for the teacher education program
 - NM legislature funding formula is being adjusted to give more emphasis to student retention and graduation numbers
 - Projected funds needed for deferred maintenance at NMSU is 585 million
 - NMSU freshmen enrollment system wide is up over last year (Las Cruces Campus up by 2412 students, NMSU-Global enrollment up by 33%, NMSU-Alamagordo up by 5.5%, NMSU-Grants up by 4.5%, and DACC up by 2.9%

2) Provost Committee on Addressing Enrollment Cliff

- Increase recruitment along the I10 corridor from Los Angeles to Houston and also parts of southern Texas
- NM has a negative migration of about 6,491 people (more people leaving NM than are coming to NM
- NMSU tuition compared to surrounding universities is very competitive
- Current retention rate of students at NMSU is about 72% goal to get to 80%
