 - Kevin: will be re-hiring a scholarly communications library who will be the point person, but the Institutional Repository Digital Commons has been set up, and Kevin is currently the point person. See it www.digitalcommons.nmsu.edu (front page only)
 - (premier IR available, ties into global network), supports PDF, streaming video, etc. Conversation with Grad school (Ranjit) for pilot to include a digital commons for graduate requirements
 - Ellen: how to encourage faculty to submit pre-prints—perhaps a memorial in Faculty Senate to encourage this as a valuable part of P&T
 - How does this circumvent publisher's contracts that forbid sharing? It depends on the copyright agreement
 - This is going to be made available to entire NMSU system
 - Further discussion is needed for how to encourage its use and effectiveness
- Nathan Camp, the library's Emerging Technologies Librarian, sharing results of 3-D scan of the large murals in Lobby of Hadley Hall
 - Nearly completed
 - Should this documentation be vetted through DEI?
