Whereas, Karen was so important as an artist that it became a part of her job description; when Karen was involved in a project, everyone knew that the end product would be of professional quality;

Whereas, Karen was always ready to help; she served as the staff representative on many committees, would help anyone out with a fax or an errand, was a patient and kind listener, and she knew everyone, knew where everything on campus was located, and never sent a student in the wrong direction for help;
