• Sr. Associate Provost James McAteer

Dr. McAteer invited at least 3 faculty members to join a task force created to look at uneven class offerings during the week. This was followed by questions and discussion from senate leadership members. It was mentioned that any changes made at main campus will not be affecting the branch campuses as they don't seem to encounter class scheduling issues. Senator Karen Frye volunteered to be part of the task force.

Dr. McAteer also clarified the "standard language" about the AI policy in course syllabus. Instructors choose one of the three options for a particular course, use the "standard language" for the chosen option and can then add anything else appropriate or tailored for that particular course. The idea behind providing "standard language" is to increase clarity and reduce confusion among students while providing three options and the flexibility to the instructor.
